

In isolation instead of in school (INISS):

How do young people in Scotland feel about Covid-19, school closures and exam cancellations?

UNICEF UK, Scottish Government and University of Edinburgh are working together to **ask young people about their experiences of missing school and missing exams due to Covid 19 and the effects on mental health and wellbeing**. The results will be used by Government to help plan support for secondary school pupils across the country.
