3.	<p>Scottish Government Update and Discussion Lewis Paterson, Fiona Lawrence and Mick Wilson</p> <p>Lewis and Fiona provided an update in relation to a number of key areas including the 2020 NIF, SNSA, E-learning and Insight. Additional details are included in the SG update (already issued).</p> <p>There was a discussion about the 2020 NIF template; it was noted that the changes in the format were beneficial. The network also considered the forthcoming 2020 Insight release.
