2.	<p>Collaborative Improvement - Feedback and learning from Inverclyde Michael Roach</p> <p>Michael provided more detail on the Collaborative Improvement (CI) work that had taken pace in Inverclyde. The focus of work had been on DYW. It was noted that the process had been highly valuable, rigorous, not required lots of additional evidence, and had been collegiate and non-threatening. The impact of the approach in Inverclyde was highlighted.</p>
3.	<p>Education Scotland – Update and discussion Guch Dillon and Elizabeth Montgomery</p> <p>Guch provided an update in relation to the progress visits and the thematic visits. It was noted that the outdoor learning report had been published.</p> <p>An update was provided about the recovery visits which started on 7 March 2022. Around 150 establishments have self-nominated. ES are planning for a resumption to inspection from next session and keen to work with ADES as they develop this.</p>

David provided an update in relation to the OECD report, NIF and the Scottish Attainment Challenge.
