<b>1.</b>	<p><b>Scottish Government – Update: NIF and SNSA</b> <b>Kit Wyeth</b></p> <p>Kit provided an update around the work that the SG is undertaking to revisit the guidance underpinning the NIF. Feedback was sought on the revised SNSAs.</p>
<b>2.</b>	<p><b>Collaborative Improvement – Feedback and learning from Edinburgh</b> <b>Jackie Reid</b></p> <p>Jackie provided more detail on the Collaborative Improvement (CI) work that had taken place in Edinburgh. The focus had been on inclusion, in particular vision, support and resources, processes and leadership. It was noted that the process had involved over 70 staff, had been highly valuable, reflected the local context and had supported ongoing improvement.
